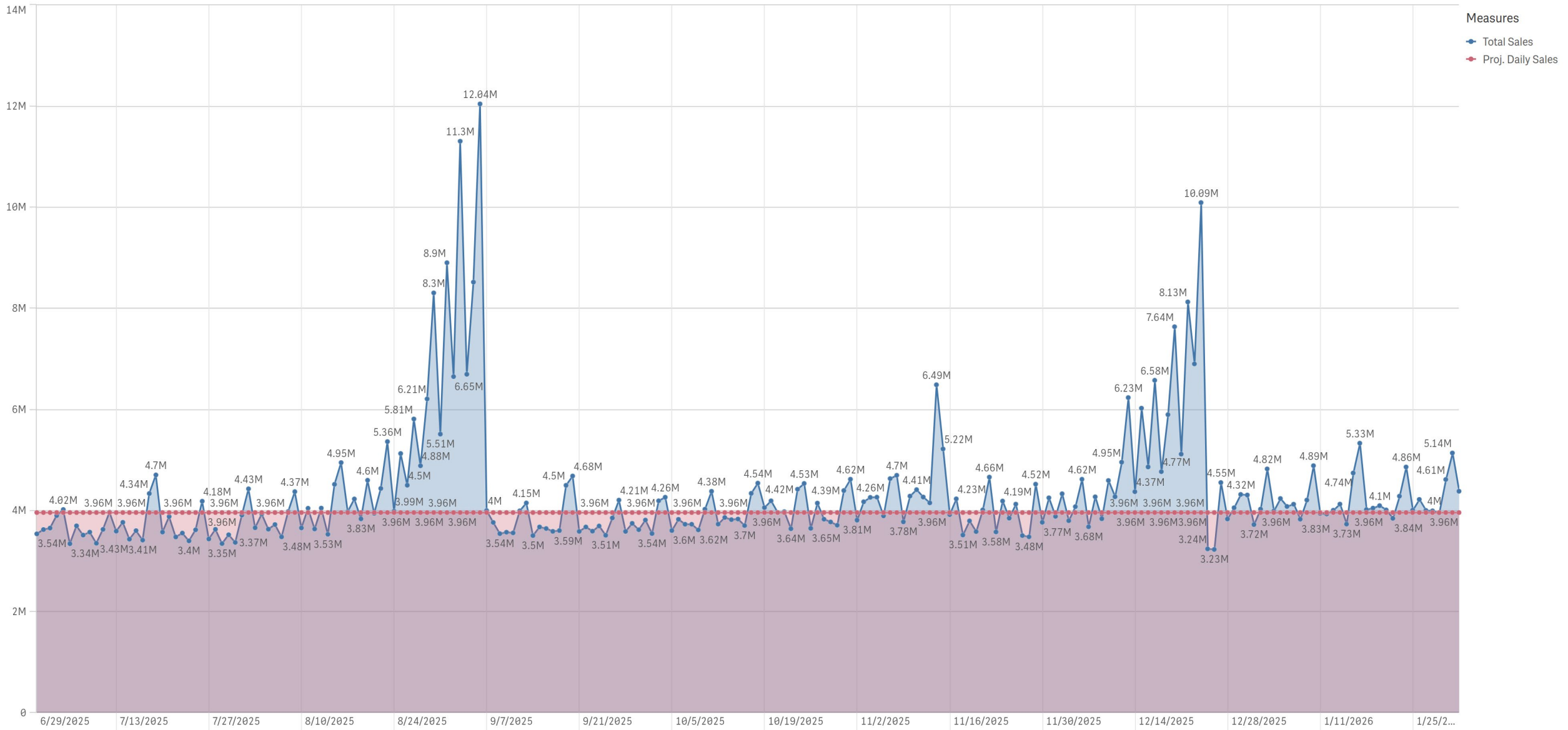

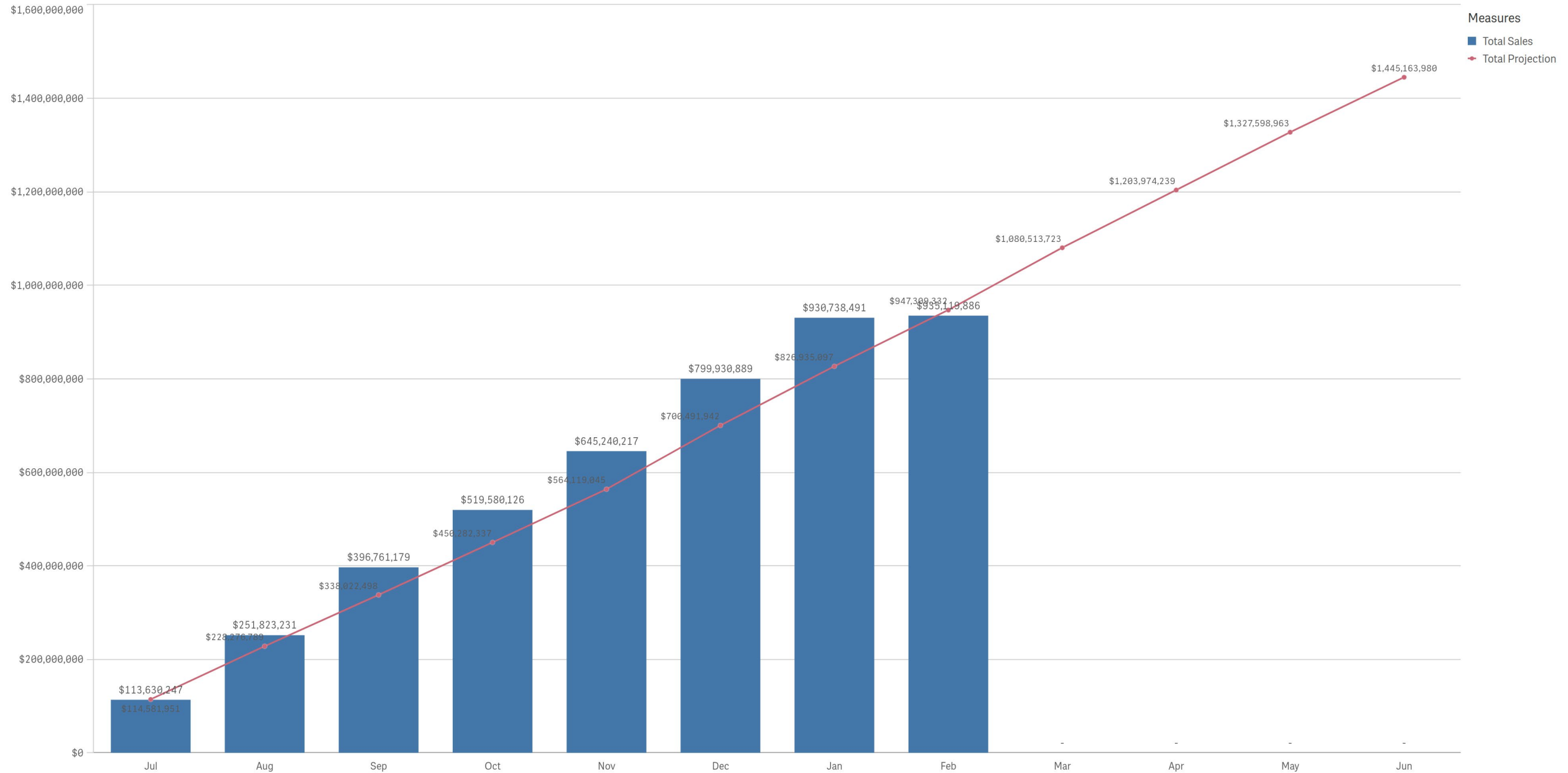
# Daily Sales vs. Goal

FY 2026 Total Sales vs. Projection

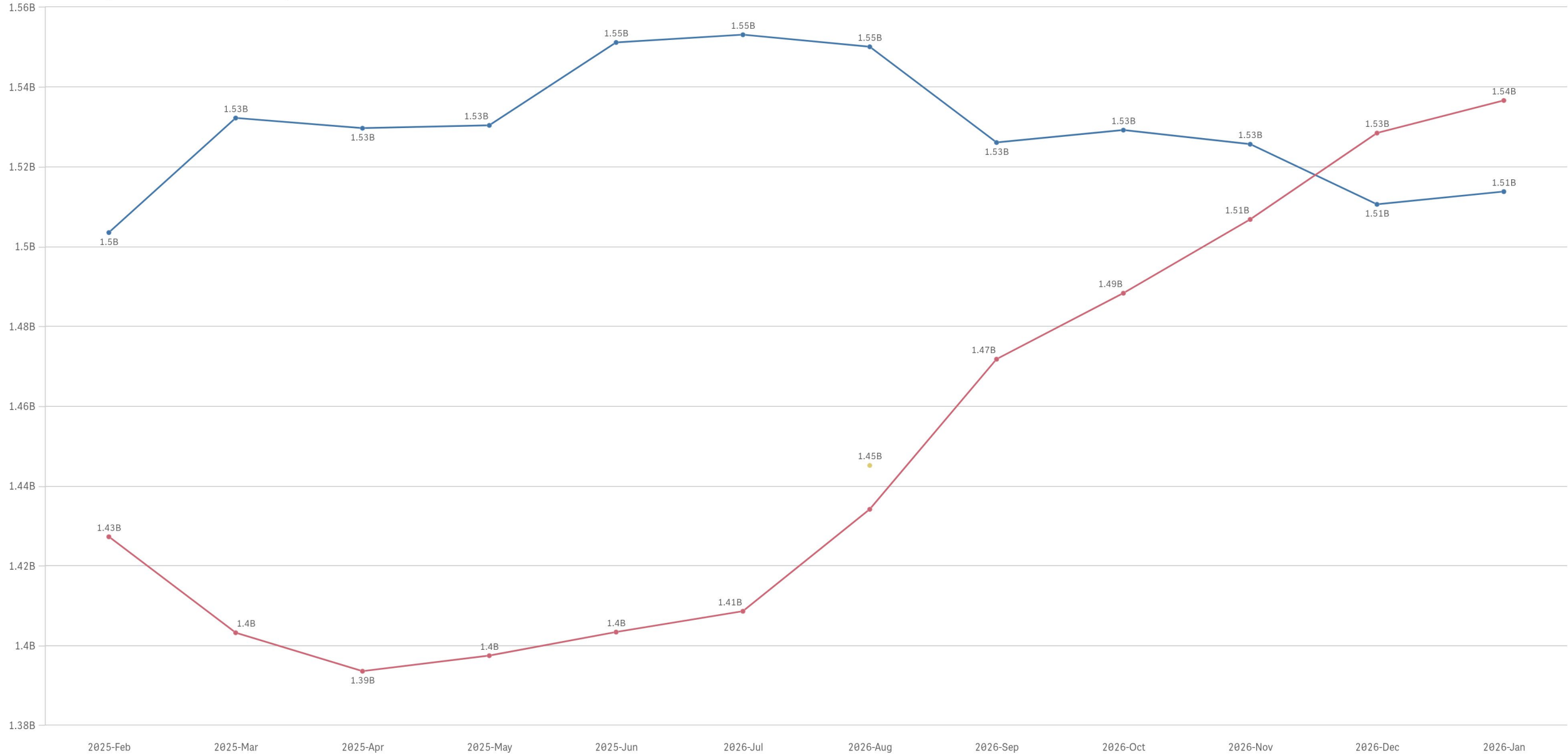




# Rolling 12 Month Total Sales

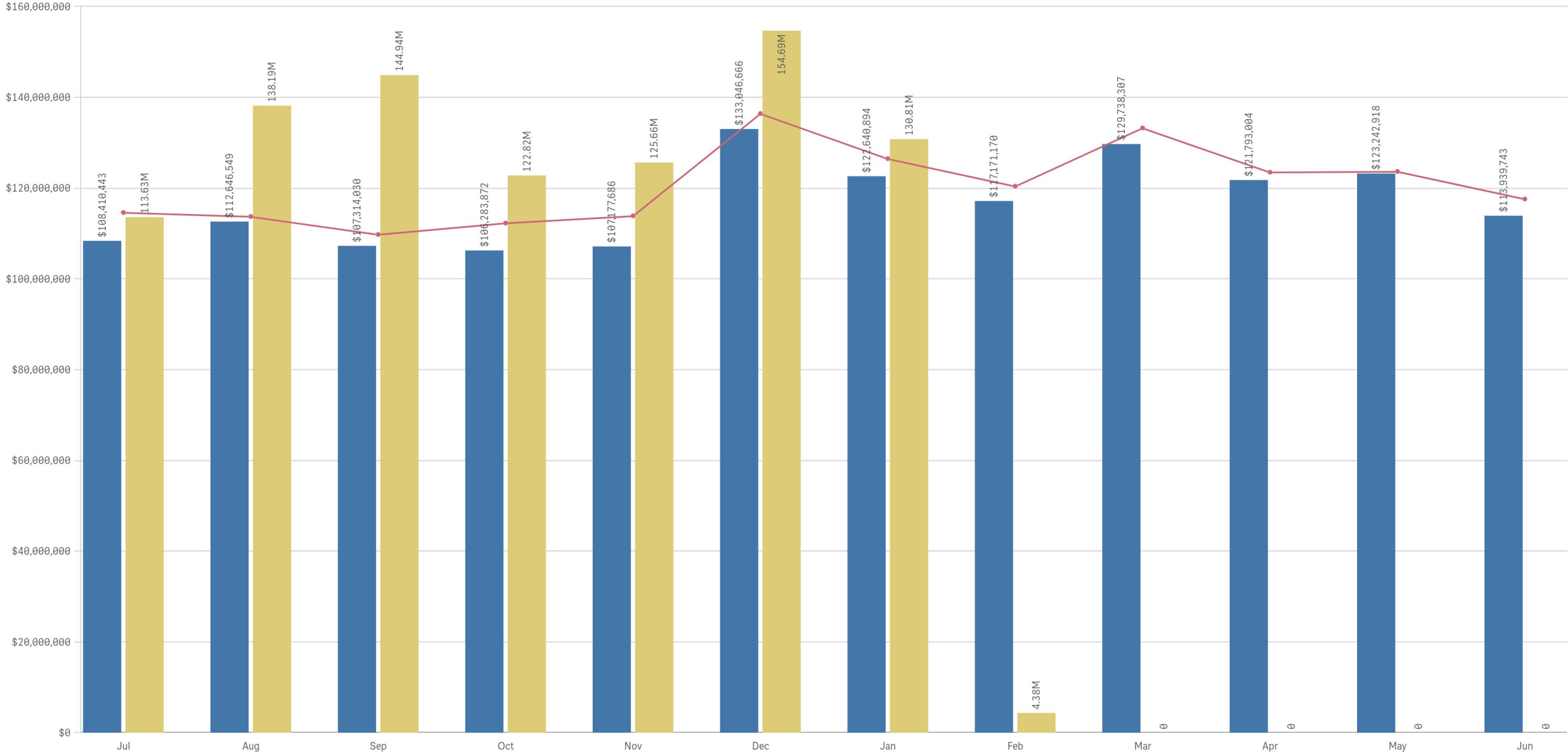

### Sales FY 2025 vs. 2026 vs. Projection

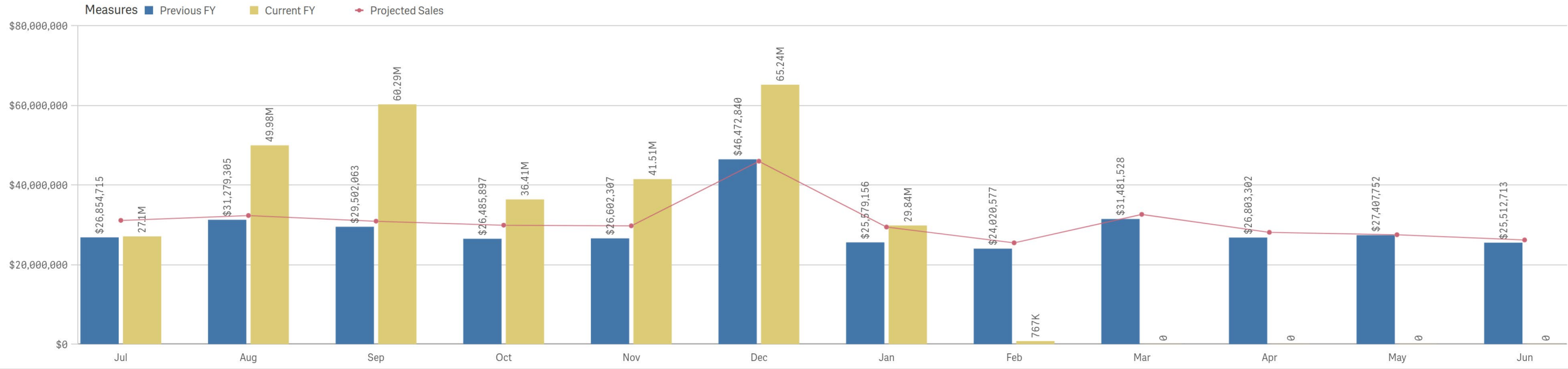

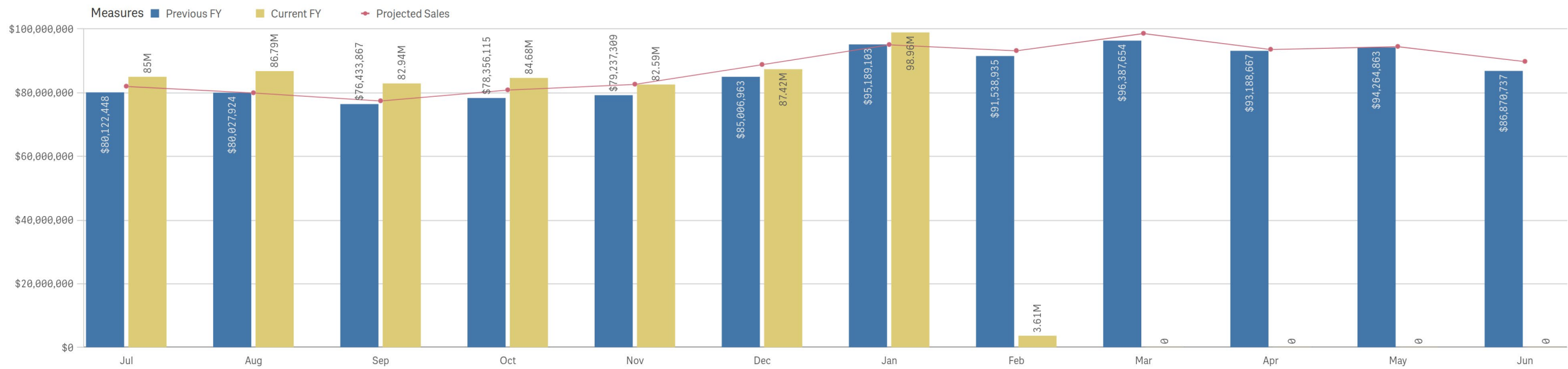

### Draw Sales FY 2025 vs. 2026 vs. Projection



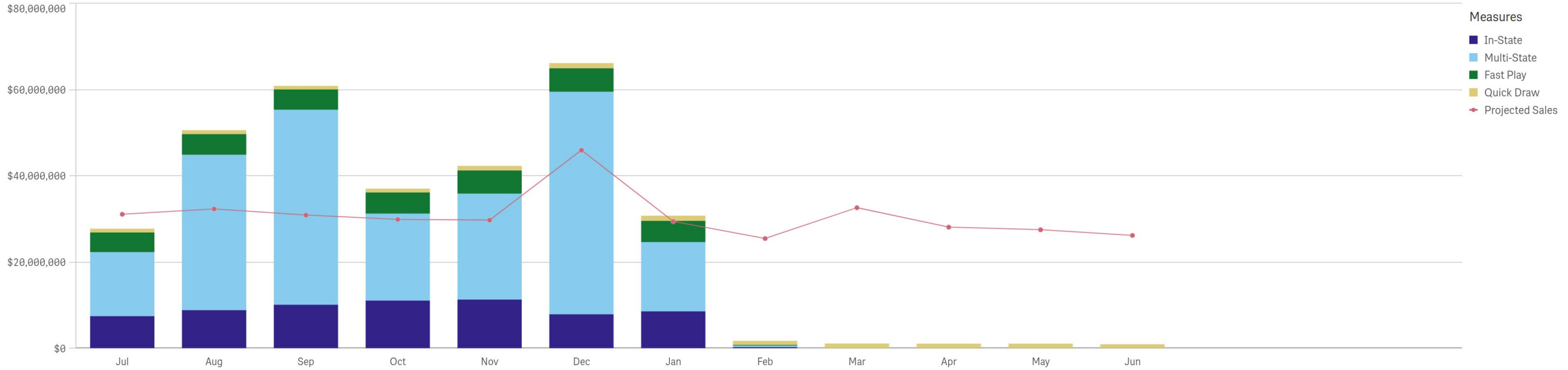
### Instant Sales FY 2025 vs. 2026 vs. Projection



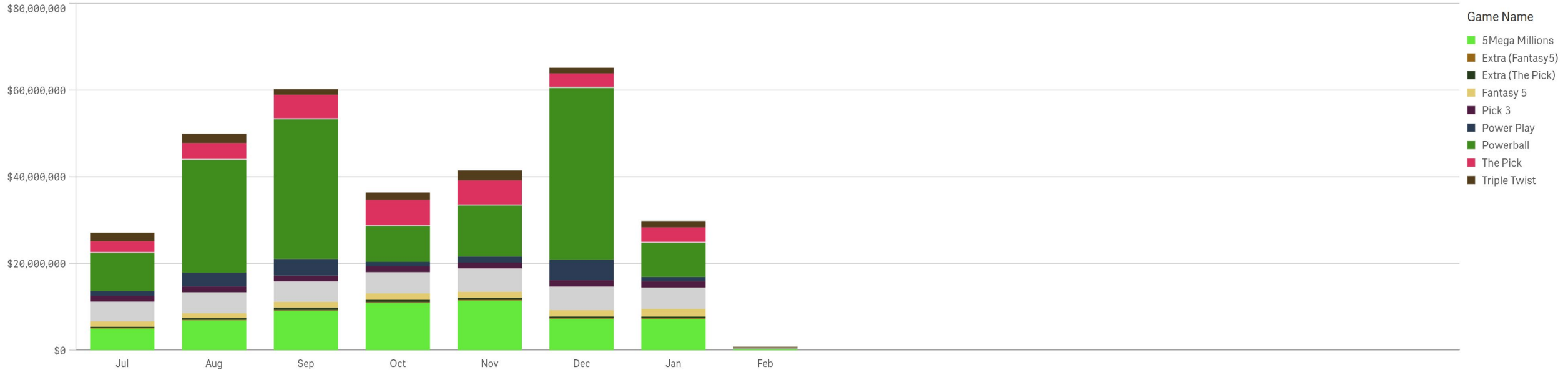


# Draw Sales by Month

### FY 2026 Draw Sales by Game Type



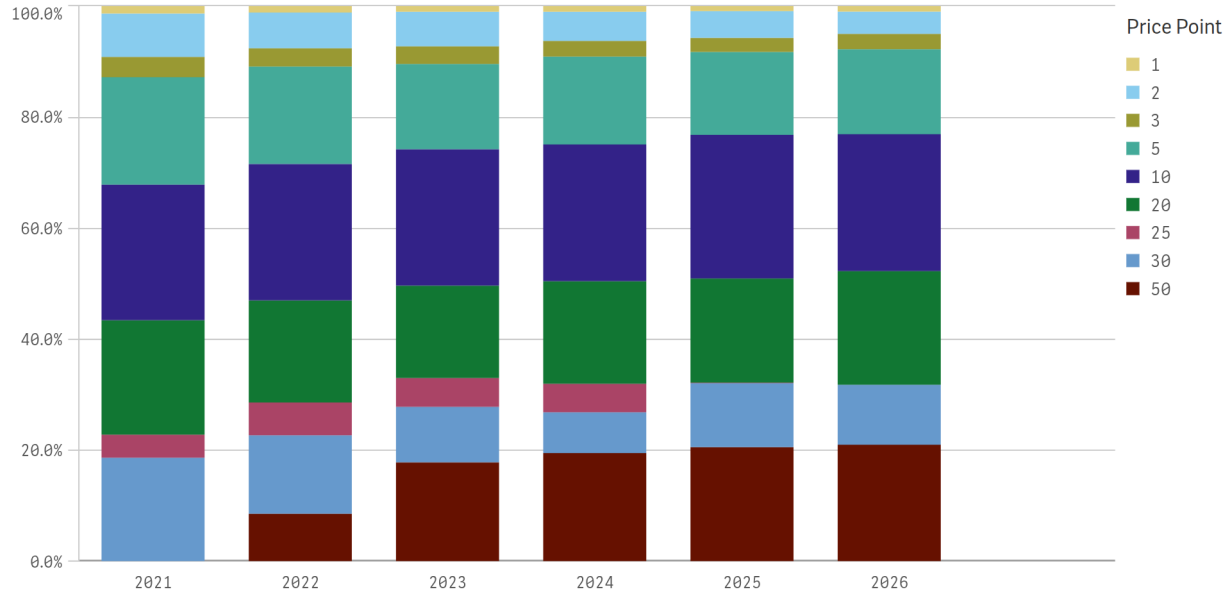
### FY 2026 Draw Sales by Game



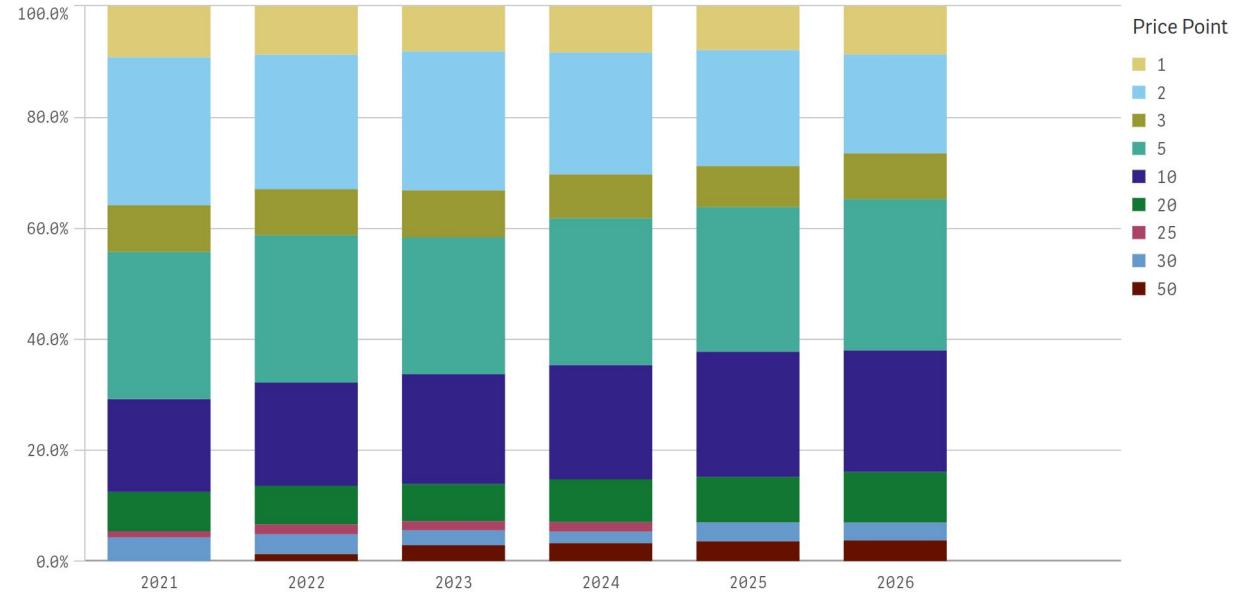


# Sales by Price Point - Scratcher and Pull Tabs

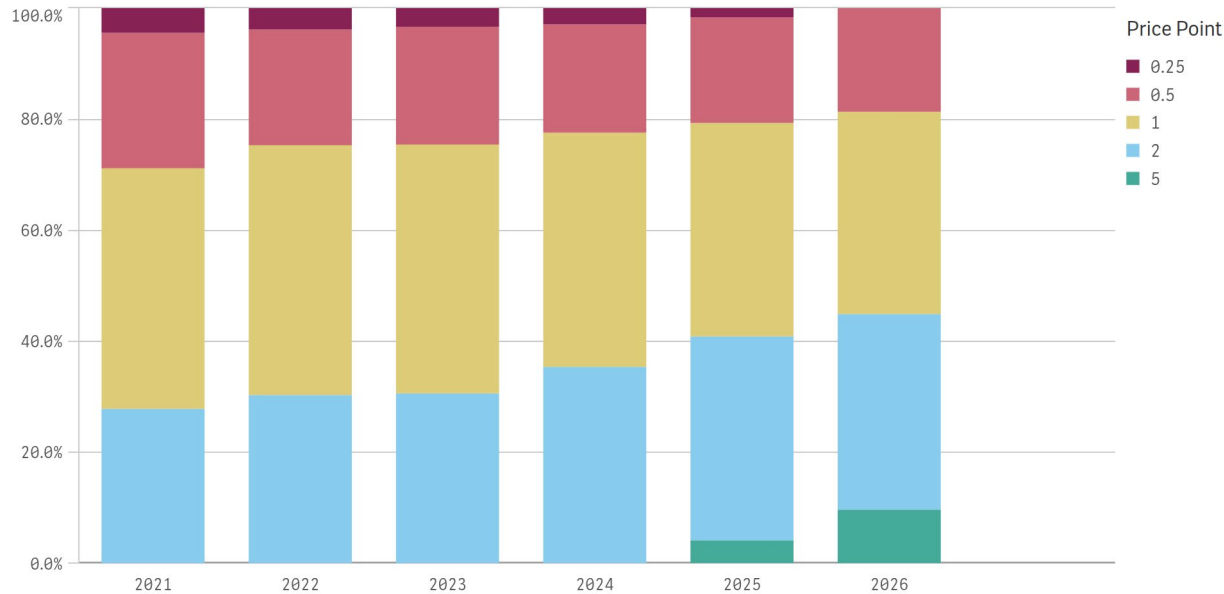
### Based on Dollars Sold - Scratcher



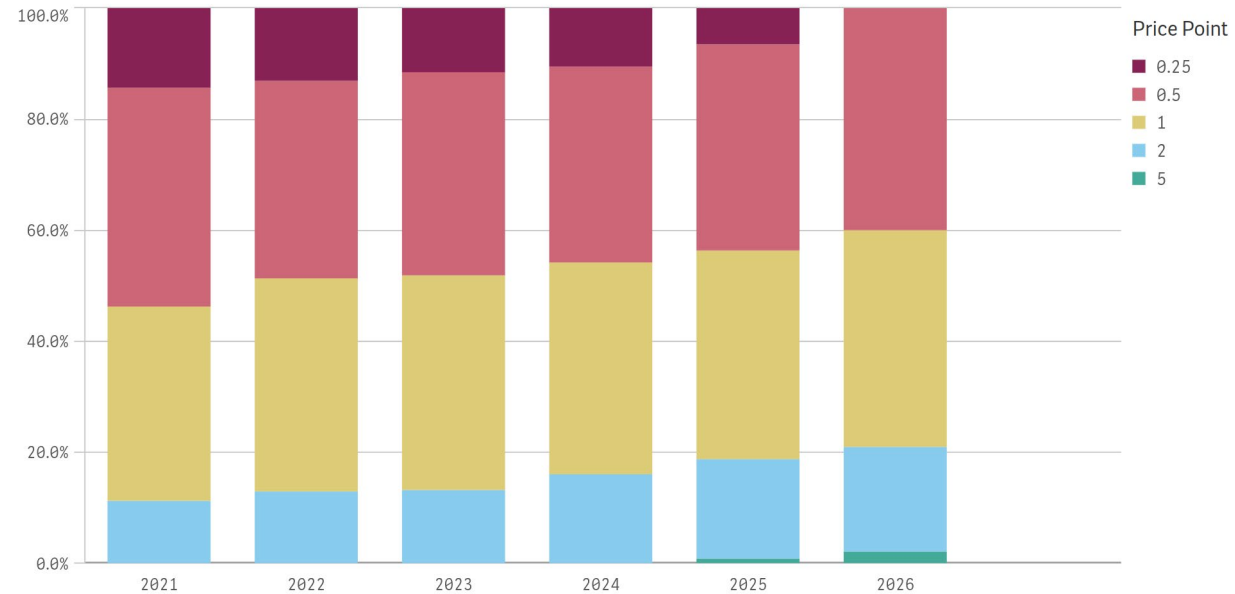
### Based on Tickets Sold - Scratcher

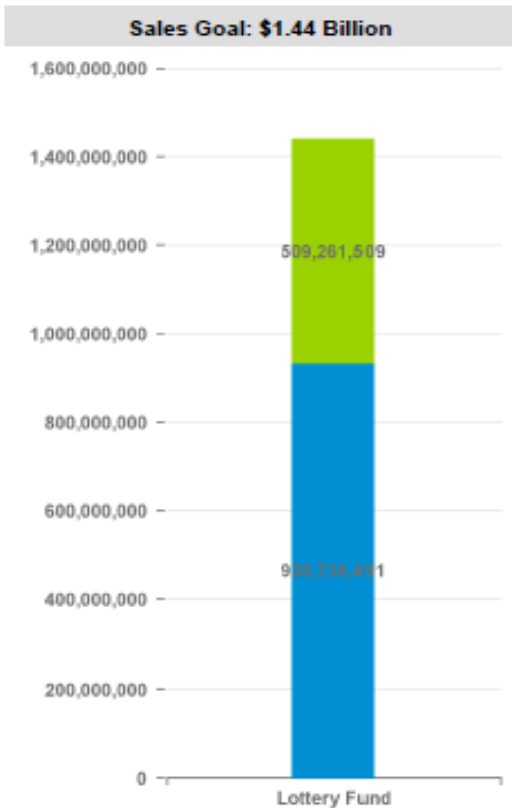
