The Arizona Lottery will be holding an oral proceeding on the proposed rules governing the authorization and operation of lottery courier services in Arizona. The oral proceeding will be held on June 23, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. The oral proceeding will take place at the main office of the Arizona Lottery, located at 4740 E University Drive, Phoenix, AZ 85034.

To ensure that the oral proceeding operates efficiently and that all participants have an opportunity to make their comments, the following rules will be in effect.

Purpose of the Hearing:

- 1. This public hearing is conducted by the Arizona Lottery as part of the rulemaking process for the proposed rules authorizing and regulating lottery courier services in Arizona.
- 2. The purpose of this hearing is to provide an opportunity for the public to present oral comments, arguments, data, and views on the proposed rules, and for the Arizona Lottery to gather information relevant to the rulemaking.

Public Hearing Rules:

- 1. **Registration to Speak:** Any person who makes an oral presentation shall fill out a speaker's registration card prior to speaking. Ariz. Admin. Code R6-1-105.
- 2. **Time Limits:** To ensure all interested persons have a meaningful opportunity to speak, all oral comments will be limited to three minutes. The Arizona Lottery reserves the right to adjust time limits based on the number of speakers.
- 3. **Scope of Comments:** Comments should be confined to the substance and form of the proposed lottery courier service rules.
- 4. **Written Comments:** The Arizona Lottery will accept written comments during the duration of the meeting. The comments will be made a part of the record.
- 5. **Prevention of Undue Repetition:** The Arizona Lottery may take measures to prevent undue repetition of comments. Speakers may be asked to summarize their points if they have been substantially covered by previous speakers, or to simply state their concurrence with previous testimony.
- 6. **Conduct at the Hearing:** All persons attending the hearing shall conduct themselves in a respectful and orderly manner.

- 7. **Removal from Proceeding:** Any person engaging in disruptive behavior may be asked to leave by the Presiding Officer.
- 8. **Modification to Rules:** The Presiding Officer reserves the right to make reasonable modifications to these procedures as necessary to ensure fair, orderly, and efficient hearing.
