




Daily Sales vs. Goal





FY 2024 Total Sales vs. Projection






Rolling 12 Month Total Sales


Sales FY 2023 vs. 2024 vs. Projection





Draw Sales FY 2023 vs. 2024 vs. Projection




Instant Sales FY 2023 vs. 2024 vs. Projection






Draw Sales by Month










Sales by Price Point - Scratcher and Pull Tabs















Transfer Amount by Beneficiary

<u>Crossword #1420.</u> This \$2 game has a top prize of \$10,000. This game will be printed at a quantity of approximately 7.6 million tickets.

Festive \$500s #1464. This \$5 game has a top prize of \$50,000. This game will be printed at a quantity of approximately 2 million tickets.

Blazing Heat/Black Ice #1468. This \$10 game has a top prize of \$100,000. This game will be printed at a quantity of approximately 2 million tickets.
